Question #1

Question #2

To what extent would a Trinity Scholarship in the range of \$300 to \$1,000 make a postsecondary education possible for you? To answer this question, indicate your level of need for a scholarship (listed below), and then explain why you chose this level of need. Feel free to add any other information that you think is important. ‘Postsecondary’ refers to any education and/or training after high school graduation.

- My ability to attend a postsecondary institution of my choice does not depend on a Trinity Scholarship because I have other resources available that other people may not.
- While I can manage without a Trinity Scholarship, receiving an award will help me pay for postsecondary-related expenses.
- Receiving a Trinity Scholarship will change which postsecondary school I am able to attend; for example, attending a public rather than a private university and/or attending a community college instead of a public university. Also, attending a public rather than a private trade school would be another example.
- Any Trinity Scholarship I am awarded will significantly help me to attend a postsecondary school.
- Without a Trinity Scholarship, it is unlikely that I will be able to attend a postsecondary school.
